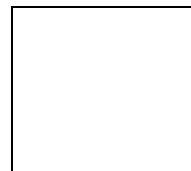

We are delighted that you have found us. We understand that this is a special day for you, one of the most important in your life, and we are committed to ensuring your ceremony is as meaningful and smoothly realized as it is beautiful.

First Parish Unitarian Universalist Church of Kennebunk was built in 1773. From the Clock tower to the Paul Revere bell, to the Hook and Hastings organ, to the “tromp l’oeil” ceiling, there is much in this central place to stimulate the historic imagination.

THE COVENANT OF MARRIAGE

When two people enter into covenant, pledging to live together in loving partnership, it’s time to celebrate. It’s a special moment for you and for your families. At First Parish we endeavor to honor couples from different religious traditions, and support both opposite and same gender couples as you prepare for your wedding. We are pleased that you are interested in FPUU for your wedding location. We hope this pamphlet is helpful in answering some of your questions.

WEDDING COORDINATOR

We are happy to assist you in your preparations at our church. An FPUU member will act as your “wedding coordinator” to help you plan and prepare for the use of the church and to help things run smoothly. A wedding sexton will be available during the service to help with logistics.

INITIAL ARRANGEMENTS

As a first step, our wedding coordinator will give you a tour of the church facilities and discuss your general plans with you. To reserve a date for the wedding, you will need to complete the Wedding Contract in which you provide information about your wedding plans and agree to observe the conditions for the use of the church.

MINISTER

The minister of FPUU is available to help you plan and officiate your ceremony, subject to scheduling. You are also free to choose another minister or justice of the peace to officiate your wedding. The wedding coordinator can provide you with a list of available ministers and justices of peace.

FACILITIES

Our sanctuary is suitable for small, intimate gatherings and has seating for up to 350 for larger ceremonies. There are rooms where the wedding party can assemble. We also have several rooms appropriate for receptions. We have a playroom with toddler aged toys if needed.

DECORATIONS

The couple is responsible for arranging decorations necessary for the service. These decorations may include candles, flowers, greenery, aisle runners, pew bows, etc. Floral arrangements and decorations should be placed to avoid damaging furniture, woodwork or fixtures.

MUSIC

You may use musicians or vocalists of your choice. In addition we have musicians available. We have a piano, sound system, CD player and organ.

PHOTOGRAPHS

Photographs and video may be taken anywhere including the sanctuary. You will be asked not to take photos during the ceremony except for the photographer and then no flash.

LICENSE

Marriage licenses are issued at the town or city level. Both parties must visit the town office to apply for the marriage license. Check with the town hall for more information. Marriage licenses are valid for 90 days. There is no waiting period required.

POLICIES

~Smoking is not permitted in the building at any time.

~No rice, bird seed or confetti may be used on the church property. Bubbles are an appropriate substitute.
